About Rebound:

Rebound is a grassroots, community-based, non-profit based in the Twin Cities. It was created to regain possession of the life trajectory of young Black males in the Twin Cities. Rebound, Inc. seeks to address the overrepresentation of young Black males in the juvenile justice system by providing innovative, holistic, and community-centered, education, advocacy, and rehabilitation solutions

Jordan House is a group home providing culturally specific services to social services or court-involved males between the ages of 14 and 21 to successfully reintegrate them into their families and communities

Services include therapy (individual, group, and family), community reintegration activities, college tours, leadership activities, community service, culturally specific mentors, and more

Services Provided

- Screening and assessment
- Social and interpersonal skill development
- Cognitive Behavioral Therapy
- Transition and life skills development
- Opportunities for physical exercise and recreation
- Access to community resources to meet the educational, medical, dental, mental health, and chemical dependency needs of its residents
- Family Support

Jelani House Information

With a capacity to serve 6 young men, Jordan House:

- Employs a diverse staff of qualified individuals with Bachelor's degrees in corrections, criminal justice, sociology, psychology, social work, education or related fields/experience
- Staffed with 1 staff to 6 residents during waking hours
- Provides case management services to participants and their families during, and for up to one year after, their stay at Jordan House
- Provides services to juveniles receiving Human Services, as well as to those involved in delinquency proceedings, and others who are under court supervision
